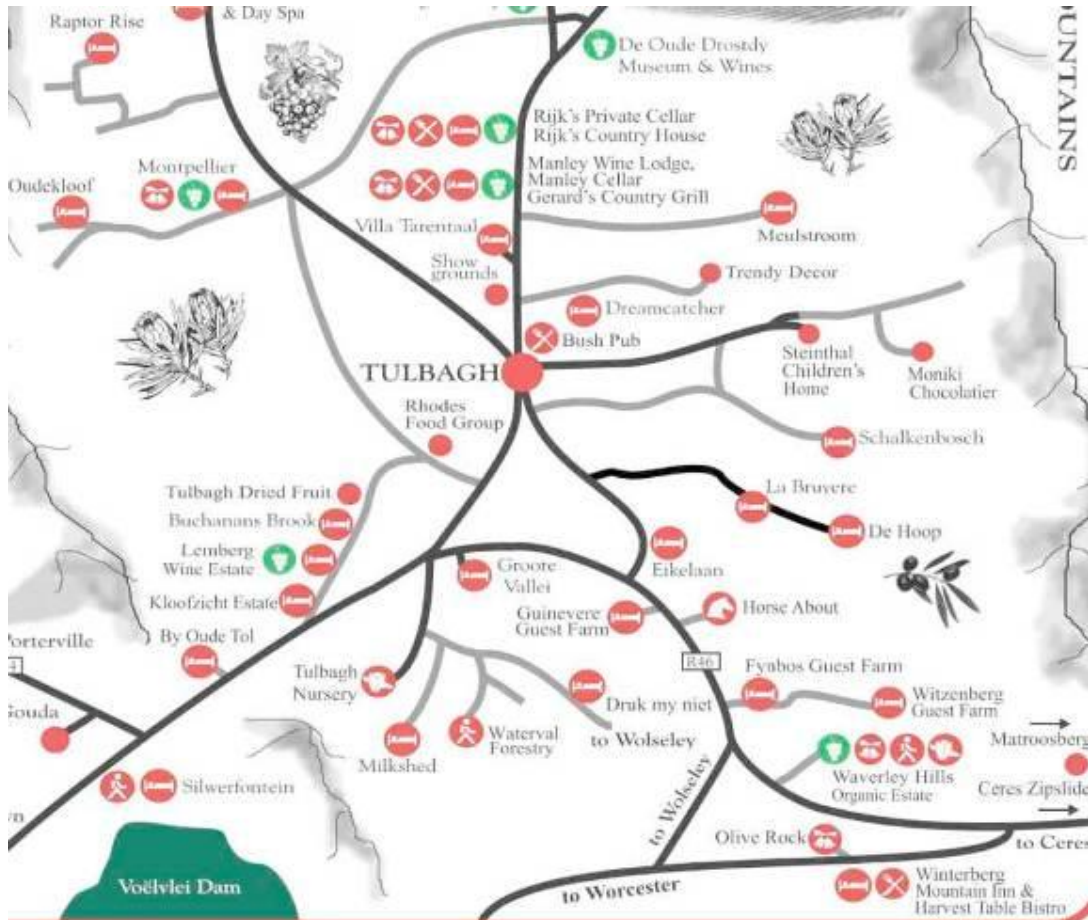


Horse About is based on the de Heuvel Estate on the R46, please remember that pre-booking is essential.

You can find us on google maps as [Horse About Trails](#), however once on the farm please follow our directions otherwise you will be directed up an old very rough farm road!

Do Not rely on GPS as it may lead you astray.



### Directions from Tulbagh – please note GPS is not reliable!

Drive straight out of Tulbagh and take the road to Ceres/Wolseley. (do not turn right to Cape Town as you leave Tulbagh) About 5 km from Tulbagh you will come to a junction where the R46 joins – turn left (says Ceres/Wolseley). Pass Wild Olive Farm on your left. Approx 1.5 km turn left at **Horse About Trails** sign. Drive through white gates “de Heuvel”. Drive straight up towards buildings. Drive through the parking area.

Continue up the road, which is now gravel. Pass house on your right. Turn right at the arrow & wine barrels immediately after the house, follow this road for 3,5 kms up the hill until you see horses ahead, park on right.

**Directions from Cape Town/Paarl**

Take N1 towards Paarl. Take Klapmuts / Wellington turnoff (R44) turning left. Just before Wellington, turn left again (Hermon/Ceres) following R44. Continue on this road through the Nuwekloof Pass where it becomes the R46. **Do not turn left into Tulbagh** - continue straight towards Ceres. Pass Wild Olive Farm on your left, turn at next sign on left – **Horse About**, drive through white gates (de Heuvel). The gate (if closed) is manual. Drive straight up towards buildings. Drive through the parking area.

Continue up the road, which is now gravel. Pass house on your right. Turn right at the arrow & wine barrels immediately after the house, follow this road for 3,5 kms up the hill until you see horses ahead, park on right.

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**From Ceres/Wolseley**

Take the R46 towards Tulbagh – after the second Wolseley turn off (on left) you will pass Boontjies River sign post. Approximately 3 km after the Boontjies River Rd, pass Weltevrede Road on your right. 1 km further turn right at **Horse About Trails** and through white gates (de Heuvel) The gate (if closed) is manual. Drive straight up towards buildings, keep straight.

Continue up the road, which is now gravel. Pass house on your right. Turn right at the arrow & wine barrels immediately after the house, follow this road for 3,5 kms up the hill until you see horses ahead, park on right.

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**Stuff to know and T&C's – Please read through completely!**

- Wear comfortable LONG trousers, no buttons, zips or bling on inner leg and you must be able to sit comfortably (not tight jeans)
- Closed shoes – ideally with a flat heel (like a boot) or sports shoes. No barefeet, sandals or crocs
- All riders are required to sign an indemnity form on arrival.
- Payment can be via EFT prior to the day or cash on arrival, we do not have credit card facilities.
- Please note that should any confirmed rider decide at the last minute not to ride, the full charge still applies. This applies to if children are afraid and don't want to ride, we recommend you discuss any concerns before hand with us.

- For the sake of safety & horse welfare - We do have a weight limit of **95 kgs/BMI of 29**. All participants are required to supply weight & height at the time of booking. Please provide accurate details as we cannot exceed this limit, should we feel a rider is unsafe to ride, we reserve the right to cancel.
- Helmets are compulsory for all participants and included in the price.
- All our trails are weather dependant, although we usually only cancel due to pouring rain or strong winds. Final times and confirmation will be sent 3-4 days prior to the ride.
- **Cancellations** within 12 hours or less and **no-shows** will be liable for 100% of the quoted costs.
- Please arrive at least 15 minutes before your ride to allow for introductions and paperwork.
